Material List:

Please also be intuitive: if you think of materials prior to the workshop that are not on this list please bring them

Watercolour/ Drawing paper x 1 sheet – min 180 gsm

Cartridge paper x 2 sheets

Found objects /purchased for mark making eg cardboard, matchboxes, craft board, travel tags, drink coasters, coloured papers, card etc

Canvases: own choice of size and quantity – this will become more apparent as the workshop unfolds

Wood: can be MDF, Marine plywood, found wood

Paints: Acrylic and watercolour – primary colours, incl black and white and any other colours of choice

Small tub of gesso/primer

Sandpaper

Brushes: soft and bristle: a broad range of sizes from fine to large and also some super fine (size 00 – 2) : (these can be purchased at USQ Bookshop)

Watercolour pencils and any other watercolour mark making materials student may have: eg watercolour crayons etc

Coloured pencils (incl grey led)

Inks: own choice of colours but preferably a small range of different colours

Paint pens: (USQ Book shop and Office works stock these: Molotow and Liquidtex are good but Uni Boss are cheaper and can be purchased from most newsagents)

Carbon paper

Collage material: old books, magazines etc

Cutting knife, cutting mat, ruler, eraser, sharpener, kitchen sponge, masking tape (purple painters tape from Hardware as this will be more gentle on your paper and won't tear or get stuck)

Rags and water container to clean brushes

Approximate cost of materials \$150

Please note that these costs are ***approximate***, and depend on factors such as quantity, quality etc

N.B. It is advisable to mark your equipment for easy identification.

Bring a Coffee mug – regular black tea and coffee, full cream milk and sugar **are** supplied by the School. **should you require decaf, herbal teas, other milk types or artificial sweeteners please feel welcome to bring your own.*

Brushes, paper, notebooks and pencils are available to purchase on campus.

Mask - in accordance with Health & Safety regulations

Covered-in shoes must be worn in all workshops

IMPORTANT: All electrical equipment required for your class at USQ must be 'tag-tested' by a qualified electrician prior to arrival in order to comply with Queensland Workplace Health & Safety legislation. Items include: extension cords, all power tools etc.

HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCES AND MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEETS.

If you bring any hazardous substance to the McGregor School, please ensure that you obtain a MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) from the supplier or obtain one from the manufacturer of this substance.

To do this, either ask the supplier from whom you purchase the hazardous substance or read the contact details on the hazardous substance and contact the manufacturer and ask for a MSDS. Once you have obtained the MSDS, bring it with you to the school, and hand in a copy to the McGregor School office, or the Tutor.

Hazardous substance can be: e.g. solvents, acids, some paint and glues, chemicals, fixatives, fluxes and solders.

If you are unsure, the Supplier and or manufacturer should be able to inform you if the substance is classed as hazardous.
